

"I moved from Iowa after college and have lived, worked, and played the last 41 years in Colorado, hiking, backpacking, fishing and winter sports too.

While backpacking the CO Trail with friend and CMC leader, Jan Dudley, she encouraged me to join CMC. The CT is my most memorable backpack (2nd to Peak Uruhu in Kilimanjaro NP) doing it in sections of around 32-78 miles per trip! I soloed a large portion of the mileage, which was extremely rewarding! We also included the Collegiate West side of the trail bringing total mileage to 567, and total vertical feet of 109,102'. I did this over approximately 3 summer's time.

I have been with CMC around 5 years and a Gore Range Group leader just before the infamous pandemic started, 2018-ish!"

New Comment Deadline: November 26, 2021

On August 13 2021, the Grand Mesa, Uncompahgre, and Gunnison National Forests (GMUG) released its <u>Draft Forest Plan</u> for public comment. **If you adventure in the San Juans,**



West Elks or on Grand Mesa, now is your chance to help preserve high-quality recreation on these landscapes.

Right now, the plan falls short on strong recreation policy and new wilderness recommendations - your feedback will help direct the forest to make important changes benefiting recreation and conservation for the next 20-30 years.
